Minutes of the meeting of the Inter Ministerial Committee (IMC) for consideration of proposals for setting up of Inland Container Depots (ICDs) / Container Freight Stations (CFSs) / Air Freight Stations (AFSs) held under the Chairmanship of Shri Madhusudan Prasad, Special Secretary (Infrastructure), Department of Commerce on 11-11-2014.

Inter Ministerial Committee (IMC) met on 11-11-2014 in Udyog Bhavan, New Delhi with Shri Madhusudan Prasad, Special Secretary, Department of Commerce in Chair, for consideration of proposals for setting up of Inland Container Depots(ICDs) / Container Freight Stations(CFSs) / Air Freight Stations (AFSs) in India. Following officials participated in the meeting:-

- 2. At the outset, Chairman, IMC welcomed the representative from the Ministry of Civil Aviation as a new member of the IMC.

Adoption of Air Freight Stations Notification and Guidelines: IMC was informed that the mandate of IMC has been expanded vide notification 16/5/1992 (infra I) Vol II dated 10-10-2014 to consider the proposals for Air Freight Stations. Ministry of Civil Aviation has finalised the Guidelines on Air Freight Stations. A copy of the notification and guidelines were circulated. The IMC adopted the AFS Guidelines. Observations, if any, in respect of the guidelines may be conveyed to Department of Commerce. It was pointed out that the guidelines for AFS are same as that for ICD/CFS except mainly for the minimum land requirement and scanning equipments.

- II. <u>DEFERRED PROPOSAL OF THE LAST IMC MEETING HELD ON 23-05-</u> 2014

 Setting up a Container Freight Station (CFS) at Sadayankuppam, Village No.44, Thiruvallur District, Chennai by The KCP Limited (CFS Division), Chennai (F.No.16/34/2013-Infra 1)

Since the proposals for Chennai Port area are presently on hold on account of reported congestion, it was decided that a joint visit to Chennai Port would be undertaken by the representative from Ministry of Shipping and Director (Infrastructure), DoC to assess the congestion and the progress of the seal verification. Further, CBEC was requested to reconsider it comments. Meanwhile the proposal will be kept on hold and taken up in December 2014 meeting of IMC.

Setting up an Inland Container Depot (ICD) at Tumb, Taqluk Umergoan District-Valsad, Gujarat by Navkar Terminals Ltd. (F.No. 16/9/2014-Infra-I).

Representative from Ministry of Railways informed that the developer has been asked to submit an alternative plan keeping in mind the DFC alignment. CBEC was requested to reconsider its comments. The developer was advised to furnish the CLU certificate from the State Government authority concerned. IMC will review the case in the next IMC meeting.

Setting up a rail linked ICD at Anuppampattu Village, Chennai by M/s SICAL Multimodal and Rail Transport Ltd. (F.No. 16/09/2012-Infra-I).

Extension of Lol (2nd) granted beyond 30-06-2014 upto 31-03-2015. It was mentioned by the developer that Café Coffee Day has purchased 52% of the shares in the company and that there is a change in the ownership but no change in name. IMC directed the developer to send an application to DoC for seeking approval for change in ownership.

Setting up of a rail linked ICD at Palwal, Haryana by M/s Hind Terminals Pvt. Ltd. (F. No. 16/25/2009-Infra-I)

Extension of LoI (2nd) granted beyond 31-10-2014 upto 31-03-2015. Developer reported that recently an application has been submitted to Railways regarding the railway land for connectivity to the Terminal. It was informed that the DPR is already approved. Ministry of Railways was requested to consider the request on priority.

The developer stated that all infrastructure work has been completed and the inspection has also been carried out by the Jurisdictional Commissioner in first week of November 2014. Extension of LoI (3rd) granted beyond 31-07-2014 upto 31-01-2015.

In the IMC meeting held on 19-09-2014 the CBEC representative stated that the Sec 7 (aa) notification would be issued within one month. However, in the IMC meeting held on 11-11-2014, IMC observed that till date CBEC has not issued Notification under Sec 7 (aa). The IMC took note of all these four proposals and decided that a holistic view will be taken once the issues relating to congestion outside JNPT port are addressed satisfactorily.
